

FRENCH BOULEDOGUE – RED WINE Syrah - Grenache



Appellation: IGP Pays d'Oc

Blend: 40 % Syrah – 60% Grenache

Alc./ Vol.: 14 % Alc. /Vol

Soil: Vineyard with very mineral soil, mainly sandstone, influenced by a Mediterranean

climate.

Winemaking: The winemaking process begins with cold maceration to extract the maximum amount

of fruit, followed by gentle fermentation to remove the hard tannins. The wine is then $% \left\{ 1,2,\ldots ,n\right\}$

matured for several months in vats.

Color: Ruby-red color.

Noze: The nose is enhanced by aromas of black berries and garrigue (thyme, rosemary).

Palate: This wine has a velvety, elegant texture on the palate, with good length and a beautiful

balance.

Serving temperature: To be served at 18°C.

Preservation: Up to 5 years in good storage conditions.

Food pairing: A perfect match for prime rib, venison or a plate of mature cheeses.
